



## **Velocity Audio Visual Services Timeline**

1981 – Dave Howell forms Coast Video Productions.

1985 – Toby Russell starts mobile music business.

1989 – Dave Howell joins SDTV and helps build Moblielink, nation's first fully deployable remote uplink/production truck.

1990 – Toby Russell forms EventAVision audio visual company.

1991 – Dave Howell joins AVHQ, becomes Area Director in San Diego.

1999 – Toby Russell and Dave Howell merge businesses to form Velocity Audio Visual Services, LLC.

2002 – Velocity AVS opens office at Morena Boulevard location in San Diego and purchases first truck.

2003 – Velocity AVS is selected as the in-house audio visual provider for The Dana Inn on San Diego Bay.

2005 – Velocity AVS moves to larger San Diego location on Convoy Court to accommodate growing inventory, and purchases second truck.

2006 – Velocity AVS adds third vehicle to fleet of trucks.

2006 – Velocity expands and opens satellite office in Tempe, Ariz., to serve growing nationwide client list.

2007 – Velocity receives Best Lighting and Technical Production Award at the 2007 Arizona Event Industry Awards.
